Infinity Math & Science High School Dedicates Computer Lab to ISU

Infinity Math, Science & Technology High School at Little Village Campus will dedicate its computer lab to Illinois State University and the Chicago Teacher Education Pipeline program. ISU donated 23 mini-tower Celeron computers with flat panel monitors to the school to help Infinity meet its 1:1 ratio of computers to students. More than 200 students will use the lab daily to create multimedia art, digital photography and digital portfolios along with their normal daily homework.

Infinity also celebrates its third anniversary as a school this year, and marks the third year of partnership with ISU and the CTEP. ISU professors have provided onsite professional development in mathematics to Infinity faculty and developed assessment tools for the school's problem-based curriculum.

Infinity offers student teaching to ISU students and has hosted the ISU/Little Village TEACH College Prep summer program. TEACH (Teacher Education and Access to College for Highschoolers) encourages students from Little Village to become teachers, providing students and their parents seminars on post-secondary education, college applications and financial aid; high school students also have opportunities to tutor and mentor students at elementary schools in Little Village through the program.
